Abb Jean-Hippolyte Michon who authored the term 'graphology' by merging two Greek words 'graphein' (to compose), and 'logos' (science). He is the originator of 'The Society of Graphology' and the first to do scientific work on handwriting. His follower J. Crépieux-Jamin arranged the progress of Michon and allocated the handwriting into seven basic components as speed, pressure, form, dimension, continuity, direction, and order[1].

Graphology is the study of writing in view of a developing group of information which is always being tested in handy utilize.[2] Since it is a Proceeding and developing knowledge of learning, and not a classified framework like fundamental arithmetic, the student ought not to be frightened to discover shifting, now and then clashing understandings approaches to a stroke or shape. 

and space between lines in writing. Author has examined 25 tested handwriting and compares it with the Graphology Expert and gets 25 similar results from 25 tested writings available.

4.1 Baseline

The baseline in an individual's handwriting reveals a lot of information about the user. Baseline can be downwards, rising upwards and balanced. Each type reveals a particular personality trait of writer. And the traits of personality are shown in below Table 1.

4.2 Letter Slant:

It is related to writer's emotional direction and degree of emotional control. About 77 percent of writers write with a right slant, 15 percent with left slant and rest 8 percent write vertically. Below Table-2 shows different meaning of letter slant [3].

Extreme Right	Lack of self-control, Impulsive, unrestrained, Intense, very expressive, low frustration tolerance
Moderate Left	Reflective , independent , objective , no understanding , Difficulty in expressing emotions, Difficulty in adapting
Extreme Left	Repressed childhood , early rejection, Fear of the future, defensive

4.3 Pen Pressure:

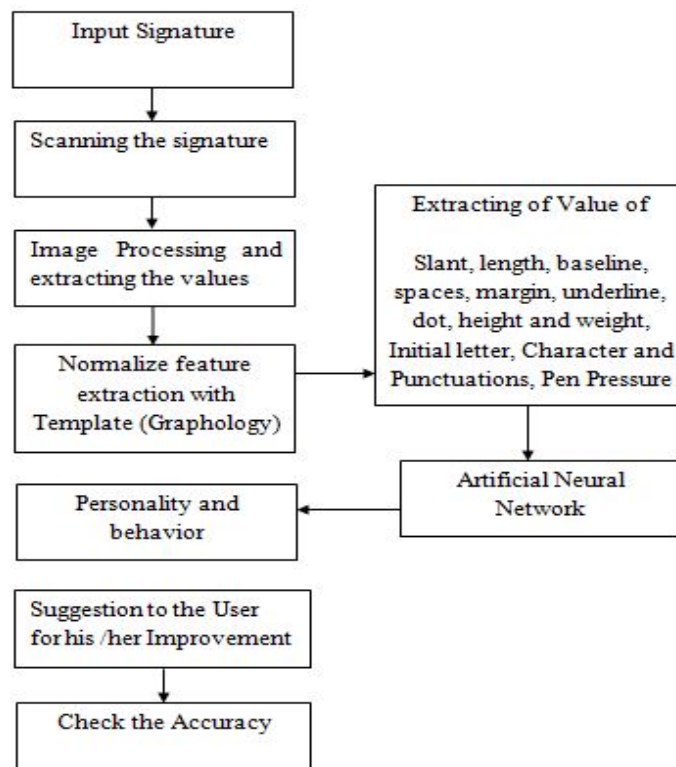
